110 Athletes 30 Female 80 Male

Winning time was 59:58 (Marc Flavin) which makes the course fast, competitive but also beginner friendly. The bike route adds the little challenge for beginners.

Issues:

Getting Marshalls to volunteer on the day is a major problem.

Registration on the day was challenging; a combination of been the first race post Covid & people showing up late and not having a one-day triathlon licence was an issue.

One of the recommendations is to engage the TI portal for race entry so that participants can sign in online the night before.

Feedback from Murroe community is that they were not notified. Road signs where erected, but more can be done locally.

More barriers around transition area was the only feedback from TI.
